



# ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION POLICY

PB Sea-Tow is committed to maintaining a pollution-free operation, and will adhere to the guidance given in ISO 14001:2004.

The Company is extremely conscious of the delicate balance between its operations and the environment. Any operation that it undertakes which may impact upon the environment will be performed in such a manner as to minimise or negate an adverse result. This includes commitment to their established procedures, aimed at preventing any type of pollution or environmental damage to the land, air and sea.

In order to achieve this goal, PB Sea-Tow and its employees will also adhere to all National, International and other applicable legal and regulatory standards, related to the protection of the environment.

PB Sea-Tow is committed to continual improvement. This will be achieved by continuously monitoring environmental objectives and targets, and by reviewing any opportunity to improve. The use of internal and external audits, together with regular management reviews, will assist in maintaining these objectives.

Contractors working on any Company vessel or property (which includes offices of work) will be responsible for providing proven environmental practises and procedures, that are equal to or better than that of PB Sea-Tow Ltd. If the practises and procedures are unable to be shown to be equal to or better, then the Contractor will be obliged to adhere to the Company's own work management procedures. All visitors (identified as not performing any work for the Company) will be given suitable on-site guidance, or by a 'work place' safety induction as deemed appropriate at the time. These will be given by the Responsible Person, as designated within the ISO Business manual or vessel's SMS (Safety management System).

Any incidents, accidents or hazards related to this policy must be brought to the immediate attention of management. The procedures established within ISO Business or SMS manuals are to be followed.
